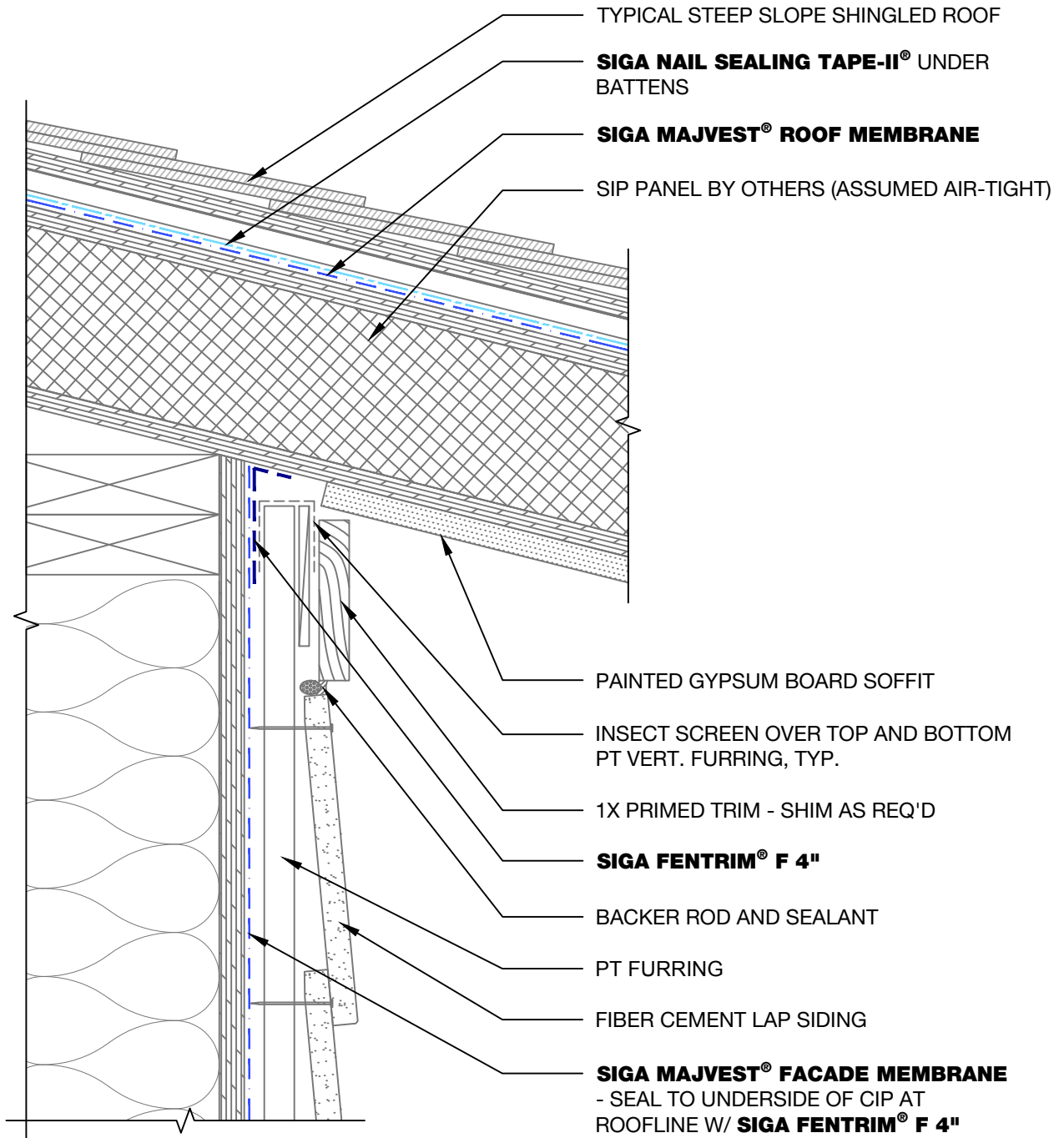

This drawing notates the recommended minimum tape width for the specific application. Wider tapes may be necessary depending on the circumstance. SIGA Wigluv® and SIGA Fentrim® may be used interchangeably, except in the case of concrete and masonry substrates. With SIGA Wigluv®, strengthen aforementioned substrates with high performance primer, SIGA Dockskin®.

All materials comprising the drainage plane should be installed in shingle fashion (bottom-to-top) to ensure that water is channeled to the exterior, with the exception of spot damage repair to SIGA Majvest®, and round, square, vent, and knife-plate penetration tape flashing sequences as drawn.
